



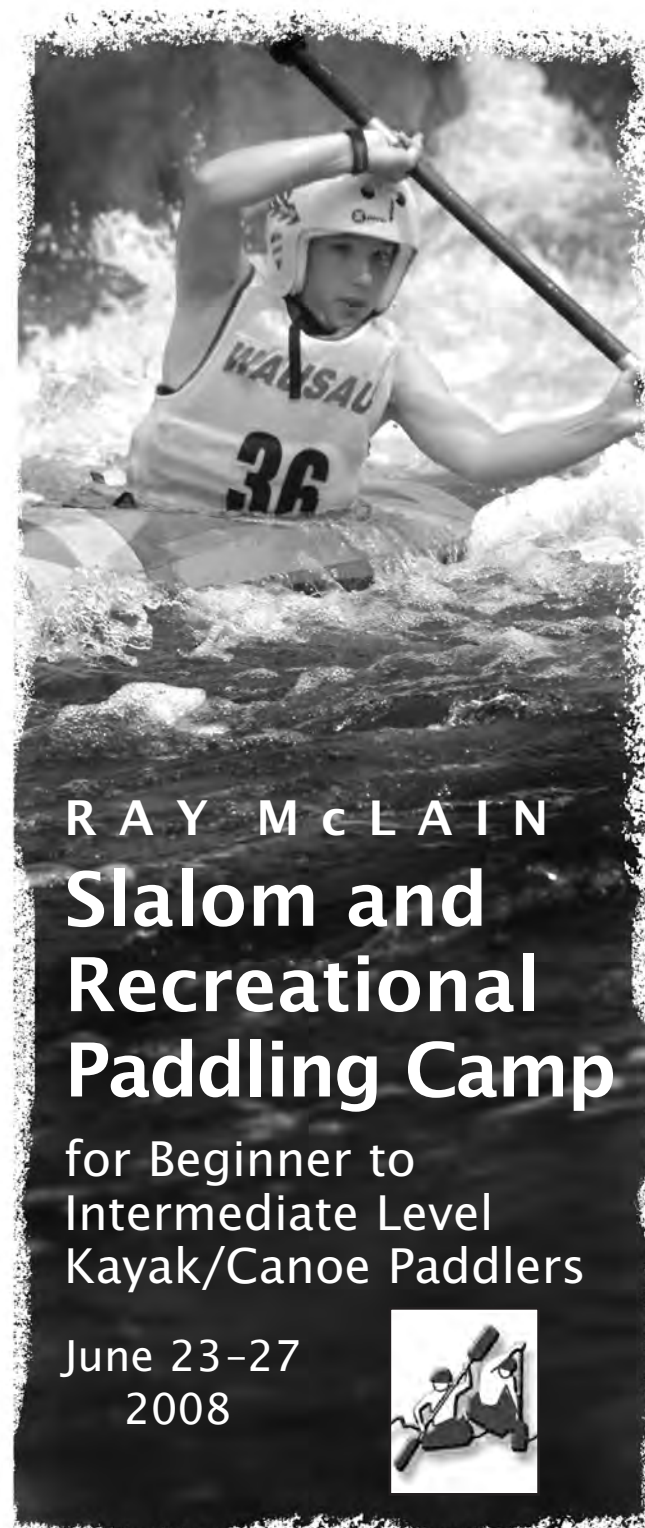

**Slalom and

Camp Overview

The Wausau Kayak/Canoe Corporation is again sponsoring a whitewater slalom and recreational camp for youths and adults. The camp is open to beginner through intermediate level kayak and canoe paddlers. Experienced coaches will be present to work with the participants. Both racing and recreational paddling skills will be covered during the camp.

During our on-water sessions, paddlers will be divided into ability groups, with two structured workouts (each lasting two hours) each day, with practice time between workouts. Individuals will be programmed according to ability and interests. Camp members will be spending one day at the Red River, with approximately five hours spent on the water. All other paddling sessions will be held on, or next to, the race course near downtown Wausau.

Camp participants may range in age from 10 years old and upwards. Maturity of campers must be sufficient to participate attentively in a structured learning group, respect the property of others, take care of their belongings in a camp environment, and have a desire to learn paddling skills. Swimming ability and comfort in the water is required. Each participant under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult. Several participants may be supervised by the same adult, but that adult is responsible for those participants whenever they are not training. A limited number of slots have been reserved for adults who would like to improve their paddling skills.

Paddling Equipment

Racing style equipment is encouraged for those who have equipment available, but is not required. Equipment will be available for use at a minimal charge for those who don't have their own equipment. Sign-up for equipment is required prior to the camp. It is recommended that applicants register early if they require PFDs (lifejackets) and helmets, as these items are in very short supply. Open boats outfitted for whitewater are welcome.



Check-In and Pick-Up Times

Check-in will be below the Wausau race course in the grass parking lot south of the VFW at 12:00 noon on the first day. The first included meal will not be until dinner, so please arrive fed. Pick-up will be at 3:00pm on the last day at the same location.

Accommodations

Lodging for the camp will be at YMCA Camp Sturtevant, located about 4 miles east of Wausau. Facilities are simple. Lodging will be available through 8:30am on Sunday, June 29th, for those participating in the Wausau Whitewater Weekend. Lodging and food—including breakfasts, lunches and dinners—are included in the cost of the camp. Please bring a sleeping bag, pillow, towels, paddling gear, and personal belongings all WELL MARKED WITH YOUR NAME. Gear should be in packs or duffel bags.

Registration
